

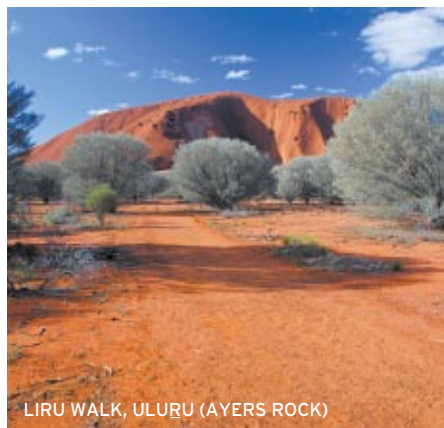
Uluru & Kata Tjuta Sightseeing

National Park Entry Fee

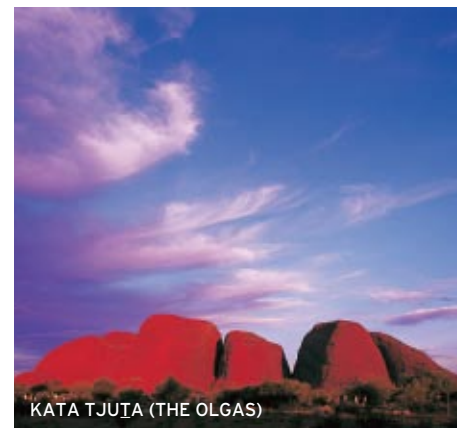
You only have to pay the NP Entry Fee once when purchasing two or more Uluru & Kata Tjuta Sightseeing Tours as entry is valid for 3 days.

Uluru & Kata Tjuta Cultural Experience

Code: Y54/Y66

Highlights: • Liru Walk • Walpa Gorge • Kata Tjuta (the Olgas)

This tour includes a morning Uluru Cultural Tour (Y54) combined with our afternoon Kata Tjuta and Uluru Sunset Tour (Y66 only). This cultural experience begins with sunrise at Uluru followed by breakfast at the Cultural Centre. Later, join your Aboriginal guides for the Liru tour, a walk from the Cultural Centre to the base of Uluru. Retrace the path of the Liru ancestors through bushland unique to Uluru. Learn how to throw a spear and about ancient bush skills such as making kiti (bush glue) and carving wooden tools. Hear traditional stories relating to this special place. After the morning tour you will be returned to your hotel for free time at Ayers Rock Resort. This afternoon visit the massive series of domes known as Kata Tjuta. The walking trail through Walpa Gorge follows the natural creek between two domes of Kata Tjuta. In the late afternoon we arrive at the Uluru sunset viewing area to witness and photograph the striking colour changes that can take place on Uluru while enjoying nibbles and a complimentary glass of wine. **B**

Uluru Sunrise & Guided Cultural Walk

Code: Y41

Highlights: • Mala Walk • Kantju Gorge

Rise early to travel to the Uluru sunrise viewing area, Talinguru nyakunytjaku, to watch the first rays of the sun set Uluru and the Red Centre alight. After sunrise accompany your Guide on the Mala Walk, which takes you through one of the most important habitation areas for the Aboriginal people over thousands of years. Continue to Kantju Gorge, where after rainfall, water can cascade over the side of Uluru and plunge some 90 metres to the ground. We drive to the site of the Mutitjulu Walk where your guide will indicate the natural features of the landscape, Aboriginal rock paintings and relay traditional stories relating to this special place. The waterhole was once an important water source for Anangu (the local Aboriginal people). Walk towards Kuniya Piti, a sacred site at Uluru. Board your coach and continue your tour around the circumference of this massive rock, with commentary from your Guide. Later visit the Uluru - Kata Tjuta Cultural Centre, for the opportunity to learn more about Anangu and Tjukurpa (Anangu beliefs and law). There is also the chance to view and purchase locally made Aboriginal souvenirs.

Uluru Sunrise & Afternoon Kata Tjuta

Code: Y52

Highlights: • Sunrise at Uluru • Kata Tjuta (the Olgas) • Valley of the Winds walk

Travel to the Uluru sunrise viewing area, Talinguru nyakunytjaku, to watch the first light of the day creep across the desert plains at Uluru. Enjoy a cup of tea or coffee and biscuits as the morning sun slowly changes the colour of Uluru. In summer watching sunrise at Uluru in the cool morning air is the perfect start to the day. In winter months we recommend a jacket as the desert air can be cold. After sunrise return to Ayers Rock Resort for time at leisure.

This afternoon meet up with a Driver/Guide and travel to Kata Tjuta (the Olgas). You will learn about the geological history of these giant domes. Your Driver/Guide will then escort you on a 2-3 hour walk in the valley between the massive red conglomerate rock. The walking path is rocky and requires a good level of fitness. Marvel at the unique flora and fauna that has survived in this harsh environment. When you reach the Valley of the Winds lookout, take some time to gaze out over the central valley of Kata Tjuta. Then take in a magnificent outback sunset at Kata Tjuta while enjoying a complimentary glass of sparkling wine.
